

MINUTES
PARK ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Brandon Park Advisory Committee met in regular session at 5:15 p.m. on October 26, 2022 at the Brandon City Council Chambers.

Roll call was taken. Members present were Barb Fish, Mindy Hansen, Jon Jacobson, Al Kirkeby, Adam Rothenberger and Leigh Zirbel. Also present was Park Superintendent Devin Coughlin. Absent: City Administrator Bryan Read and City Engineer Tami Jansma.

Member Kirkeby moved Member Fish seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Member Hansen moved Member Rothenberger seconded to approve the minutes of the September 21, 2022 regular meeting. Motion carried.

Discussion held on the Middle School tennis lights. Neighborhood concerns with the lights being on until 11:00pm, with no one on the courts. Tennis Association will discuss at their next board meeting. Approximate cost to replace with LED lights would be \$100,000.00. Member Rothenberger will discuss further with the School District. It was the consensus of the Committee to set lights to turn off at 9:30pm, and try to replace lights in the 2024 budget. Member Kirkeby moved member Hansen seconded to make recommendation to City Council to have lights turn off at 9:30pm. Motion carried.

Pool Fees Discussion – Member Zirbel moved Member Fish seconded to leave the pool fees the same for 2023, and revisit for 2024. Motion carried.

Tree board items – Devin gave an update on the tree removal program for the Emerald Ash Borer.
