Winter Sump Pump Connection Permit

Upon the determination by the City of Brandon that (a) adequate capacity exists in the sewer system, and (b) unless a winter permit is issued a potentially dangerous situation due to ice formation may occur related to sump pump discharge, the City may issue a permit for sump pump discharge into the sanitary sewer. Generally, the winter permit allows discharge from November 15th through April 1st. Any winter permit issued is not meant for discharge of large rain events.

The permit is only issued for a winter season and must be reapplied for yearly. The applicant consents to the City's entry onto the premises in the Fall for purposes of (a) determining whether the permit should be issued; (b) inspection of any permitted connection; and (c) placement by the City in the Spring of a lock cover or seal over the value of the bypass pipe. The City assumes no responsibility or liability for the backup of any sewer service, directly or indirectly connected to the sanitary sewer, that has been permitted to do so. It is the applicant's responsibility, not the City's, to maintain the sump pump and the connections to the sanitary sewer. The permit is not assignable, and any new owner of the property listed below must apply for and obtain a permit for discharge. Payment of \$50.00 for the permit must be paid at the time the application is submitted to the City; if the permit is not issued the fee will be remitted to the applicant. Discharge without a permit is subject to a \$500.00 per month surcharge on property owner's sewer bill.
